DO THIS IN REMBRANCE OF ME

In Eucharistic Prayer C (BCP 370) is this phrase, which thanks God for "blessing us with memory, reason and skill." These three gifts of grace are what make us unique in creation. In the Gospels, Jesus puts emphasis on remembering. The words of Jesus at the last supper as he gave the disciples the bread and wine were, "Do this for the remembrance of me." Also, before the bread and wine is distributed to the congregation these words are spoken, "The gifts of God for the people of God. Take them in remembrance that Christ died for you and feed on him in your hearts by faith with thanksgiving." If I were to sum up in one word the point of the communion specifically, and worship in general, it would be remember!

The Greek word for this remembering is a tongue twister, anamnesis. Understanding this wonderful word is key to the richness and meaning of the experience we call Eucharist, Communion or Last Supper. Anamnesis implies much more than just remembering. The word offers us an active process through which we can enter into the divine mystery of salvation through Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection. The word is both a starting point for our worship experience and a trajectory that flows out from our worship participation. As one of my seminary professors said, this divine remembering, this anamnesis is a moment when the past is brought into face-to-face – contact with the present and is meant to move us beyond worship into the world.

God gave us memory for a reason. As we go through our daily lives in so many ways remembering God's story, a wonderful evolutionary process occurs. Through the power of that remembering (anamnesis) we become the story.
